



Option to pay the ASC annual membership monthly.

The Auckland Shooting Club now offers members the option to pay their annual membership fee monthly via Direct Debit

How this works is the base fee is divided up into monthly payments and paid via Direct Debit to the Club's bank account. A small surcharge is also applied to cover the Direct Debit administration, software license fees and Bank charges.

The member commits to paying the full annual fee through to 30 June. Early termination fees for cancelation of the Direct Debit will equal the remaining membership fee through to 30 June.

The joining fee and any other additional fees (e.g. Pistol NZ fee) are charged separately to the annual membership fee and do not form part of the Direct Debit amount.

Direct Debit Authority Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions apply where the Member has requested to set up a Direct Debit Authority for payment of their Auckland Shooting Club membership.

Payment of the Direct Debit will occur on or around the 15th of each month and will remain in effect until such time as notice is provided by the Member to terminate the Direct Debit.

Once the Direct Debit has been established, the Member is committed to the term equating to the remaining months of the Club financial year (to 30th June) at which time unless the Member gives notice to terminate their membership with the Club the Direct Debit will roll over into the Club's next financial year and the Member's membership and commitment with the Club will continue into the next financial year.

Early termination fees will equal the remaining membership fee through to the end of the Club's financial year (30th June)

Auckland Shooting Club upon notice from the Member, will give notice to the Bank that no further Direct Debits are to be initiated under the Direct Debit Authority. Upon receipt of such notice the Bank may terminate this Direct Debit Authority as to future payments by notice in writing to the Customer. The Auckland Shooting Club will then invoice the member for any early termination fees.

The Auckland Shooting Club will provide notice by way of email to the Member prior to any Direct Debit Payment.

The Member may:

At any time, terminate this Direct Debit Authority as to future payments by giving 2 months written notice of termination to the Auckland Shooting Club at which time the Member will be invoiced for any early cancellation fee if applicable.

The Member acknowledges that:

This Direct Debit Authority will remain in full force and effect in respect of all Direct Debits passed to the Members's Account in good faith notwithstanding the Member's death, bankruptcy or other revocation of this Direct Debit Authority until actual notice of such event is received by the Bank.

In any event this Direct Debit Authority is subject to any arrangement now or hereafter existing between the Member and the Bank in relation to the Members's Account.

Any dispute as to the correctness or validity of an amount debited to the Member's Account shall not be the concern of the Bank except in so far as the Direct Debit has not been paid in accordance with this Direct Debit Authority. Any other dispute lies between the Member and the Auckland Shooting Club.

Where the Bank has used reasonable care and skill in acting in accordance with this Direct Debit Authority, the Bank accepts no responsibility or liability in respect of:

the accuracy of information about Direct Debits on Bank statements; and

any variations between notices given by the Auckland Shooting Club and the amounts of Direct Debits.

The Bank is not responsible for, or under any liability in respect of the Auckland Shooting Club's failure to give notice of the Direct Debit nor for the non-receipt or late receipt of notice by the Member for any reason whatsoever. In any such situation the dispute lies between the Member and the Auckland Shooting Club.

The Bank may:

In its absolute discretion conclusively determine the order of priority of payment by it of any monies pursuant to this or any other Direct Debit Authority, cheque or draft properly signed by the Member and given to or drawn on the Bank.

At any time terminate this Direct Debit Authority as to future payments by notice in writing to the Member.

Charge its current fees for this service in force from time-to-time.
